In Calgary May 17th to 20th, 2010

Field Sampling Course



Oak Environmental is pleased to bring The Nielsen Environmental Field School to Calgary to teach a 4-day Field Sampling Course focusing on Soil, Soil Vapour and Ground-Water Sampling. The course instructors, David and Gillian Nielsen, will conduct classroom and field training from May 17th to May 20th. The course begins with a full day of classroom instruction on environmental sampling basics; the next three days will involve morning classroom sessions and afternoon field sessions. The 3 afternoon field sessions will allow comprehensive hands-on training in soil, soil vapour and ground-water sampling techniques and related equipment.

A **direct-push rig**, operated by G & R Envirocore, will be used during one field session to collect data for site characterization purposes, to collect discrete and continuous soil samples, to collect soil-vapour and ground-water samples, and to install a monitoring well.
